If you have not already signed up for email notifications with LIC, we strongly urge you to do so. This will help ensure that you receive the most timely updates from LIC as possible.

Aloha,

The transition to a single pump was completed yesterday. However, the pump is now experiencing faults, and has been put in safe mode so is operating at lower power which means it is only pushing about 20% of capacity to higher elevations. The manufacturer has been contacted regarding repairs, and alternative pumps are being explored concurrently. While the pump is operating at about 20% of its capacity, low flows and low pressure will continue for IRRIGATION water.

Aloha,

On Tues. Oct. 29, Launiupoko Irrigation Company, in conjunction with crews from West Maui Land Company, Inc. and West Maui Construction, LLC will be transitioning from the two booster pump system to a single pump system to lift the water from LIC Well 1 to upper elevations. The work is expected to take all day, and part of Weds. Oct. 30 to re-charge the system. The reservoir will be partially filled, but please prepare for low pressure, and low flows and periods of no irrigation water on Tuesday Oct. 29 & Weds. Oct. 30.

You have probably observed the on-going prep work over the past few months. The prep-work is now complete, and to save down time, on Tuesday Oct. 29, three crews will be mobilized to make the final push. There will be a lot of activity at the two pump locations on Punakea Loop and at LIC Well 1. We hope to complete the work in a day, and be back up and running on Wednesday afternoon.

We will be emailing notices to those who have signed up for email notification, but we wanted to inform the board presidents and property managers in case you receive any calls.
